Eligibility	All competitors must hold a valid BJA, BJC or AJA licence and must present this when booking in on the day of the event. All competitors must wear a white judogi. Those holding non-BJA grades should not hold grades above the colours stated. Competitors aged 9 years or over must have completed a grading examination within the last 9 months, (applies to novices if licence held over 6 months).	
Categories	<b>A: Under 8 Years Festival (players aged 6-7 years)</b> <b>B: U12 Novice and Red Belts (players aged 8-11 years inclusive)</b> <b>C: U12 Yellow Belts (players aged 8-11 years inclusive)</b> <b>D: U12 Orange Belts (players aged 8-11 years inclusive)</b>	
Method of Elimination	<b>Judo Festival</b> All players will be put into groups of four and will participate in randori with each of their group members. There will be no placing and all will receive a participation medal. <b>U12 Grade Banded</b> Where possible competitors will be divided into pools of four or five based on gender and weight. The tournament director reserves the right to amend weight categories as necessary. BJA under 12 restrictions will apply throughout.	
Weigh-In	Category A – 9.00am to 9.30am Category B – 9.00am to 9.30am Category C – 12.30pm to 1.00pm Category D – 2.30pm to 3.00pm	All competitors MUST present themselves to the weigh-in wearing competition acceptable judogi trousers, females must also wear a plain white round neck t-shirt.
